

School Counseling Services

The comprehensive school counseling program is an integral part of the school environment. It is implemented by Master and/or Doctoral level licensed professional school counselors. School counselors are specifically trained to address the issues within our schools that have a substantial impact on student learning. Serving as leaders and advocates, school counselors work with students, families, communities, faculty and staff to address issues that have a substantial impact on student academic, personal/social and career development.

Counselor activities include:

Direct services – face-to-face interactions between school counselors and students.

- School counseling curriculum (instruction/group activities)
- Individual student planning (appraisal/advisement)
- Responsive services (counseling/crisis response)
- College/Career Readiness Counseling.

Indirect Student Services - services provided on behalf of students resulting from school counselors' interactions with others.

- Referrals
- Consultation
- Collaboration
